Russian River Valley 2011 Pinot Noir

This wine displays all of the characteristics you would expect from one of Sonoma County's coolest vintages. This was the second year in a row that we, in the North Coast, experienced an uncharacteristic cold ripening period. We carefully manipulated each and every cane from each and every vine in each and every row. We naturally wanted the fruit to be kissed with just the right amount of sunshine, but with not really much sunshine to go around this task was an even more delicate balance of removing the leaves in just the right place, not too much, but definitely not too little.

The result is this wine's beautiful array of both red and black fruit, which together with the judicious use of French oak barrels, gives this wine immense complexity, depth and length.

All of these careful details will enable this wine to pair with an extraordinary array of diversely flavored and textured foods, and give pleasure to all for several years to come.
